Campus Reopening for Trimester 3, 2021/2022

This announcement outlines the return to campus guidelines, teaching and learning activities, and other matters related to the university operation. We would also like to reassure you that we are working diligently to provide a safe, secure, and conducive learning experience to all our students.

Return to Campus for Trimester 3, 2021/2022

1. The University has decided that all students including international students are required to return to campus from May 2022. The university will provide on-campus quarantine for international students upon requests when they return to campus. Please contact stad@mmu.edu.my for further arrangement.
2. Students are required to follow the standard operating procedure (SOP) provided by the University when they are on campus.
3. Kindly note that the University will always comply with decisions and any updated SOPs from the Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE) and Ministry of Health (MoH). Any updated information will be communicated to all students in a timely manner.

Teaching and Learning Activities

4. As for teaching and learning activities, the following mode will be implemented beginning May 2022 for new students and all existing students who are returning for their Trimester 3, 2021/2022:
 - All lectures will be conducted online.
 - All tutorials, labs and studios will be conducted via physical face-to-face mode. However, a special arrangement of online session (short duration of one to two weeks) will be made to those who are affected by the COVID-19 or tested positive until they are fit to attend the classes again.



Unvaccinated Students

5. Based on the current university policy, unvaccinated students are not allowed to enter MMU campuses. Unvaccinated students (local and international) are required to contact Student Affairs Division (stad@mmu.edu.my) immediately. Please note that the university can assist to make arrangement for the vaccination.
6. All teaching and learning activities will be conducted via online mode for unvaccinated students. However, the unvaccinated students are allowed to take the examination in a designated area on campus for their physical examination with strict adherence to the SOPs. The unvaccinated students are only allowed to enter the designated area and leave the venue once the examination is over.

On Campus Accommodation

7. For on campus accommodation, the priority will be given to new students and for those students who are in second and third trimester of their final year or those who have less than one year to complete their studies. Kindly contact STAD (stad@mmu.edu.my) for the on campus application.

Apps for Students

8. In order to monitor students' health on campus, students are required to update their status on a new app that will be introduced by STAD. Further information on the app will be communicated later.
